## **STEPS TO REGISTRATION FOR NEW FAMILIES**

STEP 1 - Complete the Application for Admission form.

STEP 2 - Return the Application form to the school's main office with the registration fees along with (all requested information must be complete for application form to be accepted):

1. Copy of Certified Birth Certificate – Required for Kindergarten students only. Students must be 5 years of age by the next December 2 to be eligible for enrollment.
2. "Report of Health Examination for School Entry" – required for Kindergarten and First grade.
3. "Oral Health Assessment" – required for Kindergarten and first grade.
4. Proof of Immunizations – required for all students.
5. A copy of the most recent report card (grades 1-12).
6. Standardized testing scores from previous school (grades 1-12).

STEP 3 - Arrange testing appointments (grades K-6).

STEP 4 - Student/Parent(s) interview with an administrator.

STEP 5 - If accepted, make arrangements for tuition payments.

## **ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA**

The students who are considered for acceptance at NCCS are those who:

- Have accepted Jesus Christ as personal Savior and demonstrate a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ in both word and in the manner of maintaining a consistent relationship with Him in life (i.e. church participation, youth group, etc.). Required for Jr/Sr High students only.
- Have at least one parent who has accepted Jesus Christ as personal Savior and demonstrates a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ in both word and in the manner of maintaining a consistent relationship with Him in life (i.e. church participation, etc.).
- Are members or actively involved in a Bible teaching church whose doctrinal position supports the North County Christian School's Statement of Faith.
- Have demonstrated on the admission test that they are adequately prepared to achieve well in school.
- Have a satisfactory citizenship record in the school they are presently attending.
- Are achieving an average of at least a "C" grade in the present school year.
- Desire to attend North County Christian School and are willing to comply with the school's standards as printed in the handbook.

The Admissions Committee evaluates applications on the following documents:

- Parent and student application forms (required for Jr/Sr High students only)
- References from (required for Jr/Sr High students only): (1) student's church, (2) present academic teacher, AND (3) adult friend.
- Previous academic record
- Personal interviews with admissions personnel
